

Guide for Providing California's Proposition 65 Warnings


California's Proposition 65 ("Prop 65"), also known as the **"Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act,"** requires "clear and reasonable warning" to California consumers if a product contains certain chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm. For all existing and new item listings, as a Newegg Marketplace Seller, you have an obligation to determine if the products that you sell need Prop 65 warnings and provide the appropriate warning language as required by California law. Even if your existing listing contains a Prop 65 warning, if you created that listing before May 30, 2018, you are required to update the listing no later than August 30, 2018. For any listings that you do not update by August 30, 2018, you acknowledge that no warnings are needed and any existing warnings for those listings will be removed.


How to Start

If your product listing needs a Prop warning, you can provide the correct warning using one of the methods described as follows:

Manually update through Newegg Seller Portal

1. Access Seller Portal, then open [Manage Items > Item List](#)
Search the items you would like to update.
2. Click  under Action field to access the content details.

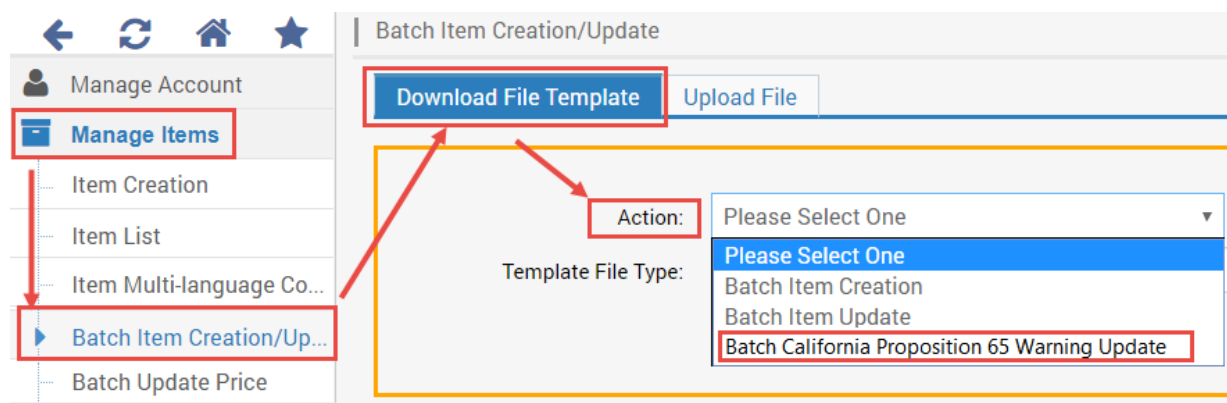

Batch update using data feed

1. Access Seller Portal then open [Manage Items > Batch Item Creation/Update](#)
2. Go to the **Download File Template** tab
3. Select the option of **Batch California Proposition 65 Warning Update** from the drop-down menu of **Action** then select the prefer format from the drop-down menu of **Template File Type**

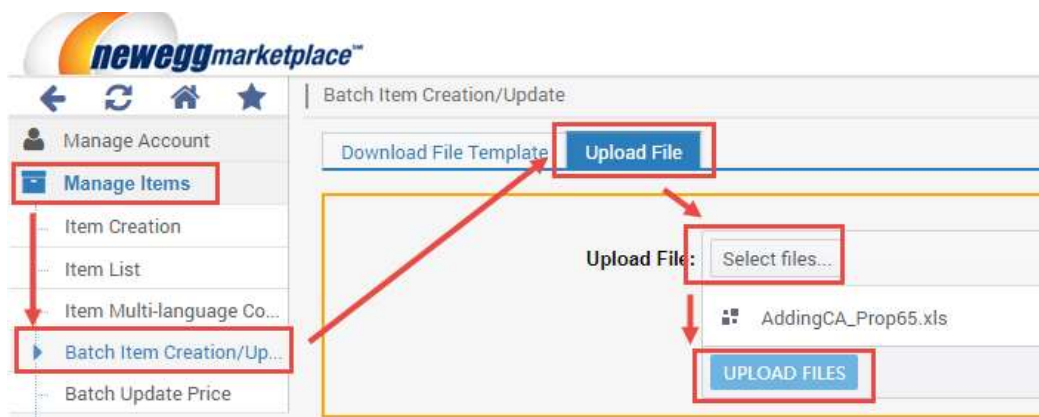


4. In the template, you will find the California Proposition 65 attributes under the **WarningType_ID**. Select the appropriate California Proposition 65 Warning Type and, if applicable, the associated California Proposition 65 Chemical Name(s). If multiple values of Chemical are available, please separate it by commas.

 - 5.1.1. Access Seller Portal then open [Manage items > Batch Item Creation/Update > Tab-Upload File](#)
 - 5.1.2. Click Select files... to upload file from your local drive.
 - 5.1.3. Click **UPLOAD FILES**
 - 5.1.4. The process time may vary depending on the how many items you uploaded. Make sure to download **Process Report** to verify result.

FAQ

Question: Under the state requirement, warnings must be tailored to provide more specific information regarding the type of chemicals in the product and the type of harm caused by the chemicals. The current Prop 65 warning is as below picture shows on the product detail, you said we have to provide more specific information. But how can we do this?



Answer: Any existing Prop 65 warning in old format currently showing on the product page will stay until 08/30. After 08/30, Newegg will display newly updated warning message. Seller can update the new warnings using one of the methods mentioned in this guide.

Question: My integration service provider still showing the old format, Prop 65 warning with available values as “Yes” and “No” only. How can we add specific information for the warning?

Answer: Currently, Newegg has not received any confirmation from service providers regarding this update. Please kindly check with service provider directly. To avoid further delay, we suggest seller update the warning based on the instruction mentioned above. Please note, the new warning messages you uploaded will NOT be overwrite by any update in old format.
